I invite you to join me to light the Flame of the Games on 21 June 2019 at DINAMO Stadium.

The Flame of Peace Torch Relay is one of the first events of MINSK 2019.

The Flame of Peace will be lit in Rome on 3 May 2019 and will travel a long way to arrive in Belarus. The Torch Relay will start at the museum of the Ara Pacis altar which is more than 2000 years old.

The Flame of Peace will ascend to the summit of Mont Blanc and then travel across Europe.

3X3 BASKETBALL

PALOVA ARENA

3x3 Basketball became an Olympic sport on 9 June 2017 and, consequently, was included in the Tokyo 2020 programme.



CYCLING – TRACK

MINSK ARENA VELODROME

The word "bicycle" was borrowed from French around 150 years ago while the invention of the device itself dates back two centuries.



CYCLING - ROAD

OKTYABRSKAYA SQ. AND MINSK CITY CENTRE

One of the most peculiar aspects of cycling is shaving. Athletes are thought to shave their legs to make treatment of scratches and wounds easier. There is also a theory that shaved legs contribute to better aerodynamics.



CANOE SPRINT

REGATTA COURSE ZASLAVL

The highest boat speed registered at canoe sprint competitions is 23 km/h.



RHYTHMIC AND ACROBATIC GYMNASTICS MINSK ARENA

Athletes can start training as early as at the age of two, but they need to be at least 16 to participate in the Olympics.



TRAMPOLINE AND AEROBIC GYMNASTICS MINSK ARENA

Trampoline became very popular in the USSR because it was used in training of astronauts.



WRESTLING SPORTS PALACE

The rules of Greco-Roman wrestling allow athletes to wrestle beyond the mat, and sometimes the bout continues in the spectator stands.

JUDO

CHIZHOVKA ARENA

In pure numbers of aficionados, judo it is the second most popular sport in the world (after football). Different sources estimate that up to 28 million people practise judo, with 8 million adepts living in Japan.

BOXING

URUCHIE SPORTS PALACE

The legends of boxing are heavyweights Sonny Liston, whose fists measured 38 cm around, and George Foreman, whose bicep was half a metre.



KARATE CHIZHOVKA ARENA

This martial art originated in China and was imported to Okinawa Island where it was named "karate", or "Chinese hand".

ATHLETICS

DINAMO STADIUM

Athletes will compete in 10 disciplines in the following order: trackathlon, long jump (women), 100m (men), javelin throw (women), 100m (women), relay 4x400m (mixed), 110m hurdles (men), high jump (men), 100m hurdles (women) and distance pursuit relay (mixed). The final event – pursuit relay – will determine the winner of the team stage.



TABLE TENNIS TENNIS OLYMPIC CENTRE

Experts say that table tennis is among the world's top 10 popular sports. It attracts a total of about 850 million players and fans around the world.



BEACH SOCCER

OLYMPIC SPORTS COMPLEX

In beach soccer, the ball is in the net every 3-4 minutes and there are about 60 shots on goal during the match.



SHOOTING - RIFLE & PISTOL, SHOTGUN

SHOOTING CENTRE AND SPORTING CLUB

One of the three Olympic shotgun disciplines is skeet. An athlete on a skeet moves along shooting positions and fires at targets flying towards each other. The best result was scored by Mikola Milchev (Ukraine) who managed to hit 150 out of 150 targets.



SAMBO SPORTS PALACE

Sambo is a complex combat sport which merges the best practices of local martial arts: fist fight, different wrestling styles, Japanese judo and sumo and other types of single combats.

ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS MINSK ARENA

The word "gymnastics" derives from Greek γυμναστική [gymnastike], from γυμνάζω [gymnazo] – "to train, to exercise", or from Ancient Greek γυμνός [gymnos] - "naked".



ARCHERY OLYMPIC SPORTS COMPLEX

Matt Stutzman is an American archer who won a silver medal at the 2012 Paralympics. He was born without both arms, but learned to use his legs and feet in everyday activities.

TICKETING CENTRES AND TICKET OFFICES

Tickets are available at the official website **minsk2019.ticketpro.by** and at ticket offices in Minsk and regional centres of Belarus.

If you want to, you can exchange an e-ticket for a colourful paper ticket to keep as a souvenir.

Ticket offices will be available at all competition venues. They will open one hour before and close one hour after the competitions.

TAKE CARE OF YOUR TICKET

Make sure not to lose the tickets you purchased at the ticket office. If you lose the original ticket, it will not be reissued. Damaged tickets can be exchanged at the Main Ticketing Centre in Minsk and ticket offices at competition venues.

RE-ENTRY IS PROHIBITED

If a sports session is less than 4 hours, the ticket does not permit re-entry to competitions and ceremonies. Once you leave the competition venue, you will not be allowed to re-enter using the same ticket.

If a sports session is longer than 4 hours, re-entry is allowed provided that you scan your ticket at the entrance.

VENUE ACCESIBILITY

MINSK 2019 will strive to be friendly to people with special needs by providing accessible seats and passageways to ensure comfort and the best experience for spectators.

There are the following types of allocated seats:

- Seats close to FoP for people with visual impairments;
- Seats close to the aisles for people with limited mobility (with canes or crutches) and people with visual impairments who use guide dogs.
- Dedicated platforms are available to spectators in wheelchairs, including with accompanying people.

Visiting Belarus visa-free for ticketholders

10 June – 10 Jule 2019 enjoy visa-free period with your ticket through any border of Belarus.

A visa-free traveler must have:

- 1. Valid national passport
- 2. Ticket for the 2nd European Games
- 3. Medical insurance of 10.000 euro (can be purchased on site)
- 4. Daily monetary allowance at least 2 base amounts* for each day of stay

TRAVEL BY CAR WITH NO TOLL!

Owners of the vehicles no more than 3,5 tons of weight and trailers towed by them are exempted from the fare on toll roads from June 10 to July 10 upon presentation of a ticket. More information at **www.minsk2019.by**



Citizens of 74 countries can stay in Belarus without visa from June 10 till July 10, including the arrival and departure days

Convenient location of Minsk means it will not take you more than three hours to get here from any city in Europe, Central Russia or the Middle East.

BY PLANE



60 direct flights operated by 19 airlines. The road from the airport to the centre of Minsk takes less than an hour (42km.

BY TRAIN

If you travel by train, you arrive at Minsk Passazhyrsky Railway Station (3, Privokzalnaya Square) which is centrally located.

Average travel time: from Vilnius – 2.5h; from Moscow – 9 to 10h; from Kiev – 10h; from Warsaw – 10h; from Riga – 12 h; from St. Petersburg – 13 to 14h.

Ploshchad Lenina metro station is right under the railway station.

BY BUS

International buses arrive at the Central Bus Station (6, Bobruiskaya St.).

Average travel time: from Vilnius – 3-4h; from Moscow – 11 to 12h; from Kiev – 11 to 12h; from Warsaw – 11h; from Riga – 10h; from St. Petersburg – 14h.

Ploshchad Lenina metro station is close to the Central Bus Station.

BY CAR

If you are a car enthusiast, a well-developed network of roads will take you from the border to Minsk in slightly more than 3 hours. Passenger cars (with gross vehicle mass up to 3.5t) will be exempt from toll on all toll roads in Belarus from 10 June to 10 July 2019. For more information please see www.beltoll.by.

CHIZHOVKA ARENA

Address: Minsk,19 Tashkentskaya St.



Fitting into the neighbourhood of the Chizhovskoye Reservoir, the sports complex consists of the big arena (8,807 seats) and the small arena (443 seats) that resemble two water droplets flowing into each other.



Belarusian sprinter Yuliya Nesterenko, who was dubbed "White Lightning", won the women's 100 metres at the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens. Her splendid victory and the result of 10.93s caught the attention of the whole world.

Since then, the Stadium has experienced a lot, including

At the moment, the brightest Belarusians in athletics are Anastasiya Mironchik-Ivanova (long jump), Alina Talay and Elvira German (100m hurdle race), Pavel Seliverstov and Maxim Nedosekov (high jump).



Makarau

At the 2004 Olympics, Belarus won a gold medal in judo when Igor Makarov proved to be the best in light heavyweight -100kg.

Today, leaders of the Belarusian team are European Championship medallist Dmitry Shershen, Junior World Champion Vadim Shoka and European Champion Maryna Slutskaya.

Mariya Koulinkvich, Alexey Vodchits, Maria Fursova, Aleksandra Fursova and Andrei Grinevich are European & World Karate Championships medallists.

It is one of the largest high-tech, cultural and sports venues in Europe and an outstanding example of modern architecture of Belarus.

Seating Capacity: 15 000

Minsk Arena includes the Velodrome, Speed Skating Stadium and main Ice Arena. The Arena can be easily reconfigured to host different sporting and cultural events.



Vitaly Scherbo is one of the most successful gymnasts of all time; he is the only male gymnast ever to have won 6 gold medals (all at the 1992 Summer Olympics in Barcelona).

Today, leader of the Belarusian rhythmic gymnastics is Katsiaryna Halkina, medallist of World and European Championships.

Uladzislau Hancharou is 2016 Rio Olympic champion in men's individual trampoline.





Cycling. Track

Sports:

MINSK ARENA VELODROME





One of Europe's best cycling tracks was built in Minsk in 2009. It is 250m long and 7.5m wide, with two bends at 41 degrees. The wood is Siberian spruce.



Tsylinskaya

Natalia Tsilinskaya is an outstanding persona in world track cycling. She is an eight-time World Champion, Olympic bronze medallist and 28-time World Cup winner.

Today Evgeny Korolek is the leader of the Belarusian team. In 2018, Korolek was World Champion in scratch and took the first place in the overall standings of the UCI World Cup 2016/2017.







SPORTS PALACE

Address: Minsk, 4 Pobediteley Ave.



Sports:

Opening of Sports Palace in 1966 commenced formation of the sports axis of Minsk – today's Pobediteley Avenue (which means "Winners' Avenue"). In 1984, Sports Palace was included in the List of Historical and Cultural Monuments of Belarus.

Seating Capacity: 3 300

Sports Palace can host competitions in 22 different sports as well as turn into a venue for concerts, shows and exhibitions.

Belarus won three medals at Rio 2016 Olympics: silver of Maria Mamoshuk and bronze of Ibrahim Saidau and Javid Hamzatau.

Tatsiana Matsko, Stepan Popov, Andrei Kazusenok, Olga Namazova, Uladzislau Burdz, Yury Rybak and Katsiaryna Prakapenka are winners of international competitions and European Sambo Championships.





Sports:

3x3 Basketball





This new sports arena in the very centre of Minsk has hosted international competitions since 2015.

"Palova" means "half" in Belarusian. It is the key term in 3x3 Basketball, since the game is played on one half of the court with one basket.

Anastasia Suschik and Anna Lappo are silver medallists of the 2015 FIBA 3x3 U18 European Championships.







FALCON CLUB

It is one of the newest modern sports and entertainment facilities in Minsk. The building resembles a soaring falcon that has spread its wings above Pobediteley Avenue and the River Svisloch. Sports:







The venue was opened in 2003, and since January 2005 it has been the Olympic training base for the Belarusian national team in shotgun shooting. Sporting Club is considered to be one of the best shooting clubs in Europe.

Anastasiya Chernyavskaya and Alesia Zaitsava are European and World Championships medallists and winners of international competitions in badminton.

The shooting range history is associated with the outstanding Semen Timoshenko, Marshal of the Soviet Union, two-time Hero of the Soviet Union.

OLYMPIC SPORTS COMPLEX





The Olympic Sports Complex comprises the following facilities: football fields with different surfaces, Palace of Water Sports and Sports and Recreation Centre. The Olympic Sports Complex successfully operates as a training venue used by Belarusian athletes and provides recreational services for the public.



Belarusian athlete Siarhei Martynau won a gold medal in shooting at the 2012 London Olympic Games. He won bronze medals at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney and 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens.

He is also three-time world champion. He reached the maximum score of 600 points six times in 15 years in the 50m rifle prone events (1997, 1998, 2000, 2005, 2006, 2012).

Anton Prilepov, Alexander Lyagushev, Hanna Marusava, Alena Tolkach, Ekaterina Timofeyeva are winners of international competitions and European Archery Championships.







TENNIS OLYMPIC CENTRE



Address: Minsk, 63 Pobediteley Ave.

Seating Capacity:

The centre is one of the key sports facilities of Belarus. It is used for training of athletes and holding tennis competitions. Its three buildings have a total area of $27,600m^2 -$ the centre takes up 5.8 hectares.









This modern building includes the main arena (3000 seats) and two training grounds which provide comfortable seating for 300 spectators.



Vladimir Samsonov is a legend in table tennis. He is a multiple winner of European Championships and threetime winner of the World Cup, winner of 27 ITTF World Tour events and ITTF World tour Grand Finals (1997), nine-time winner of the European Champions League. In 1998, the athlete ranked first in the world's men's singles rating. On top of that, Samsonov holds several world records in table tennis. Belarusian boxers Magomed Aripgadzhiyev and Viktor Zuyev are silver medallists of the 2004 Summer Olympics.

Current leaders of the Belarusian boxing team are Dzmitry Asanau (2015 European Games silver medallist), Pavel Kastramin (2015 European Championships silver medallist), and Yana Burim and Viktoria Kebikova, 2018 European Championships bronze medallists.

Regatta Course ZASLAVL was opened in 2006. Following the renovation in 2011, it became a national training facility.

Traditionally, canoe sprint is a rewarding sport for Belarus. Belarusian gold medallists are Dmitri Dovgalenok (Barcelona 1992), Aleksandr Maseikov (Barcelona 1992), Aliaksei Abalmasau, Artur Litvinchuk, Vadzim Makhneu, Raman Piatrushenka, Aliaksandr and Andrei Bahdanovich (Beijing 2008). Brothers Alexander and Andrey Bogdanovich are 2012 London silver medallists.

At the Rio Olympics, Belarusian women's K4 – Margarita Makhneva, Nadezhda Lepeshko, Olga Khudenko, Marina Litvinchuk – won a bronze medal.

OKTYBRSKAYA SQUARE AND MINSK CITY CENTRE



Seating Capacity: 500

Oktyabrskaya Square is locted in the centre of Minsk and is limited by Nezavisimosti Ave., Engelsa St. and Internatsionalnaya St. The square is 190m long and 100m wide. The east side of square features the building of the Trade Union Palace of Culture.



Vasili Kiryienka is a medallist and multiple winner of UCI Road World Championships as well as champion of the 2015 European Games in Baku. Currently, he races for Sky Procycling Team.

Nezavisimosti (Independence) Avenue has become the face of Minsk rebuilt after World War II. It features one of the world's best ensembles of Soviet monumental classicist architecture known as Stalin's Empire style.



Trinity Suburb is a cosy city quarter with numerous cafes, museums, souvenir shops and bright houses of the 19th & early 20th century.



Nezavisimosti Square is one of the country's main administrative areas; featuring the House of Government, neo-Gothic Church of Saints Simon and Helena (also known as the Red Church) as well as Art Nouveau style houses.
